Animals in region: Includes, but not limited to: • wild turkey • Raccoons • Squirrels • Deer • birds of prey • eastern bluebirds • opossums. • Red fox	Plants in region: Includes, but not limited to: • Kudzu • pine trees • oak trees • hickory trees • dogwood trees
 Animal features that allow them to live and thrive: Body covering allows animals to survive in hot and cold conditions. Claws or talons for hunting prey. Fur to survive winters. 	 Plant features that allow them to live and thrive: Plants can survive hot summers and cold winters. Aggressive growing plants with long vines (kudzu) Trees have thick bark to protect against cold winters, insects, and animal invasion. Thick bark also protects against trees drying out. Deciduous trees drop leaves in fall to minimize water loss.
